Colorado Food System

State of the State

1 in 11

Coloradans struggle with hunger, and the rate of food insecurity is substantially higher for single-parent, Black, and Latino households.

More than 17%

of adults eat less than one vegetable per day on average, and 33% eat less than one serving of fruit per day.

Over 55%

of high school students eat less than one vegetable per day on average, and 57% eat less than one serving of fruit per day.



The Issue: Food Inequities

Primary challenges that our work aims to address:



Compromised Nutrition

Economic insecurity and limited individual purchasing power leads to compromising on nutritious food.



Poor Food Environments

Community food environments promote less nutritious, highly processed food.



Food System Imbalance

Imbalance in the food system resulting from federal supports for certain commodities.



Disconnect from Food System

Food system consolidation and lengthy supply chains create a disconnect between people and their food.




Our Mission

We believe universal access to healthy, nutritious food is a fundamental human right.

Nourish Colorado is transforming Colorado's food system to ensure all Coloradans have equal and abundant access to nutritious foods from sustainable sources. Through advocacy for better policies, statewide initiatives, and partnerships with communities, and statewide and national organizations, Nourish Colorado is creating a new food paradigm. We're actively challenging the status quo and championing a future-forward food system that equitably feeds and nourishes ALL Coloradans.







Programs

Nourish Colorado is focused on three primary areas to advance food equity in our state:

- Healthy Food INCENTIVES
- Healthy Food in INSTITUTIONS
- Healthy Food Systems POLICY

All of our programs address one our more of these areas. We dedicate our time and resources to strategic programming that will have a positive impact on Coloradans and our communities now and into the future.

Double Up Food Bucks

Double Up is an innovative food incentive program designed to help low-income families access fresh fruits and veggies for free while supporting local farmers and economies.

Double Up Food Bucks doubles the value of federal nutrition benefits (SNAP, formerly food stamps) spent at participating markets and food retail stores. For every SNAP dollar spent, the shopper receives \$1 to spend on local produce, up to \$20/visit.

PROGRAM GOALS

- Direct federal SNAP dollars into regional food systems
- Document the need and demand for increased SNAP benefits
- Ensure families have access to fresh fruits and vegetables so they don't have to choose between healthy and hungry
- Support the vitality of small and medium size farms by expanding their consumer base
- Support the viability of local farmers markets and grocers





Double Up Sponsorship Opportunities

Farmers Market Sponsorship: \$25,000

Covers 100% of Double Up at a large farmers market or local retailer for a year

Farm Stand Sponsorship: \$10,000

Supports 50 SNAP families in shopping for produce at their local farm stand for the year

Produce Box Sponsorship: \$5,000

Provides 130 produce boxes for SNAP families for the year

Sprout Sponsorship: \$2,500

Helps start a farmers market's or local retailer's first Double Up season

Colorado Nutrition Incentive Program (CNIP)

CNIP increases access to and consumption of Colorado-grown produce by women, children, and older adults experiencing economic insecurity.

The program is a collaboration between Nourish Colorado, the Colorado Department of Public Health & Environment (CDPHE), local public health agencies, and Area Agencies on Aging throughout the state. Local partners manage funds provided by Nourish Colorado to buy produce "shares" - a weekly supply of fresh produce - delivered to homes or convenient community locations for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) and Older Adult Congregate Meal Program participants.

PROGRAM GOALS

- Integrate partnerships with local agriculture into federal food assistance programs
- Increase access to and consumption of Colorado-grown produce among food insecure Coloradans with a focus on women, children and older adults
- Support local farmers and growers by opening up new, untapped local markets and buyers





CNIP Sponsorship Opportunities

Nourish Sponsorship: \$100,000

Provides weekly produce shares, typically June-October, to families in 3-5 counties plus enhanced support for external program evaluation, advocacy efforts to permanently integrate the program into local and federal agency efforts, and the production of food education and culinary training videos distributed to all program participants.

Harvest Sponsorship: \$50,000

Provides weekly produce shares, June-October, to families in 2-3 counties plus enhanced support for external program evaluation and dissemination of results.

Grow Sponsorship: \$10,000

Provides 12 large weekly produce shares (feeds a household of 4-5 a week's worth of produce as well as additional grains or proteins) or 24 small shares, plus program coordination and food/culinary education.

Water Sponsorship: \$5,000

Provides six large weekly produce shares to a family or household, June-October, plus program coordination and food/culinary education.

Seed Sponsorship: \$2,500

Provides three large weekly produce shares to a family or household, June-October, plus program coordination and food/culinary education.

Local Procurement Colorado (LoProCO)

Championing Nutritious Food Environments for Children

Nourish Colorado is helping K-12 and early childhood education programs source and serve nutritious, locally produced food through LoProCO. The program facilitates farm to school by educating, connecting, and training partners with the information, contacts, and know-how they need to procure, store, prep, cook, and serve fresh, healthy food to kids.

PROGRAM GOALS

- Bring together and support local growers and institutions
- Empower culinary employees with knowledge and tools
- Create opportunities for healthier communities
- Partner with local and state agencies that can advance farm to school



LoProCO Sponsorship Opportunities

Workshop Series Sponsorship: \$50,000

Sponsors the intensive three-part workshop series for your region, providing attendance for 10-15 school districts, farmers, and partners

Culinary Trainings Sponsorship: \$10,000

Covers the cost of mileage and lodging for participants to travel to their regional workshop

Healthy Institutions Sponsorship: \$5,000

Supports the attendance of regional subject matter experts and instructors

Healthy Schools Sponsorship: \$1,000

Supports purchase of supplies, printing, and locally grown food purchases

Nourish Colorado advances a comprehensive policy agenda that builds towards a sustainable, equitable, and health-promoting food system where access to nutritious food is the norm.

As active members of state and national advocacy associations, our policy agenda is informed by partners across Colorado, including community coalitions, program partners, local, state, and national organizations.

POLICY GOALS

- Support our initiative to develop a policy roadmap that will identify changes in the federal and state food system.
- Support efforts to increase the state's Healthy Food Incentive Fund, which contribute to supporting families through Double Up and CNIP
- Support efforts to involve communities and individuals impacted by policy change in developing policy change
